I do solemnly swear that James Proopher and
William Lockhart both of Carrick County at the Date of 10th
October one thousand seven hundred and eighty
years ago held and solemn bound unto the Justice of his
Majestys Courts and their Officers in Office in the Town of
Lawrenceburg and see pounds Specie which Government will and
doth to be made certaine Recouers and Hires £1000.
I do also make and declare grants by these present Seales with and Seal
and dated the twentieth Day of October A.D. 1787.

The Condition of the above Obligation is Such that Whereas the
above Name John Proopher hath undertaken to build and
maintain a Bridge over Flatt Creek at a place called and known
by the name of South fork of Flatt Creek, The Condition therefore
of this Obligation is Such that if the said James Proopher
fail to build and maintain a good sufficient
Bridge at the aforesaid place for Peopoles and
Carriage of every Denomination for and during the Space of
One year from the 10th day of May last past
then the above Obligation to be void otherwise to remain in
full force & effect.
