I know all men by these presents that I Clayton Lord of the Shire of North Carolina and County of Beaufort have bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do bargain sell and deliver unto Simon Clayton of the said County and State three feather Beds, Horseman's Shaven head of Cattle and Chest two saws and Hogs and the said Simon Clayton as by these presents Warrant and License well intend the Sale of the said Beds Cattle Chest and Hogs, unto Simon Clayton his Heirs Executors and assigns against the lawful Claims or Claims of any Person or Persons whatsoever In Witness whereof I have set my hand and Affix my Seal this 14th day of July Anno Domini 1788.

I likewise in consideration of one Hundred pounds to me in hand paid have bargained sold and delivered to the said Amosiah Wallington One Hundred Acers of Land and all my House hold Furniture and all my Stock to the said Amosiah Wallington forever and I the said Benj. Shotton as Warrant unto the said Amosiah Wallington the said Negroes & the Property above mentioned from the Claim right Title of any Person or Persons whatsoever In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal the 14th day of February 1789.
