To all to whom these presents shall come greeting,
Know ye that we for and in consideration of the sum of fifty shillings for
every hundred acres hereby granted, paid into our treasury by the Browning
have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said
John Browning, a Tract of Land containing two hundred acres lying
and being in our County of Caswell on the Waters of Stono Creek beginning
at a pine and running thence South sixty five chain to a White Oak, thence East
thirty one chain & fifty links to a Red Oak, thence North sixty five chain
to a pine, thence West thirty one chain & fifty links crossing the Creek to the
first Station as by the plat hereunto annexed doth appear, Together with
all Woods Waters Mines Minerals hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
Land belonging, & appurtening, To hold to the said John Browning, his
Heirs and assigns for ever yielding and paying to us each sum of money
Yearly & otherwise as our General Assembly from time to time may
direct, Provided always that the said John Browning shall cause this
Grant to be Registered in the Register Office of our said County of
Caswell within twelve months from the date hereof otherwise the
same shall be void and of no effect, & In testimony whereof we have
caused our Great Seal to be hereunto affixed Witness Alexander Martin
Esq^r our Governor Captain General and Commander in Chief at
Savannah the Twenty Ninth day of October in the Seventh Year of
our Independance and in the Year of our Lord one Thousand
Seven hundred and Eighty two
