The Condition of the above Obligation is such that Whereas the above David John Smith, hath Granted unto me, fully, Given up, and Admitt^d of the said David Mitchell his Hm for cutting Timber of all kinds such as Rails or fir wood &c bearing his own line on the North side of him and on the said Smith's Land. Lining said Mitchell on the South of his Land.

Now if the said John Smith Grants and Giv^s said Mitchell all the Privileges on said Land above Designated as the it was own Land without any Collaboration or Interfereⁿ whatever that then, the above Obligation to be Used & of no Effect otherwise to remain in full force and Virtue in Law
