In the name of God Amen. This eighth day
of October in the year of our Lord one Thousand Seven
Hundred and Twenty Eight I Duncan McDonald
of the County of Caswell State of North Carolina
being in a sick and low state of Health but of sound
mind & memory (Thanks be given to God) and
calling to mind the mortality of my body and
uncertainty of this life do make Constitute Ordain
and appoint this only to be my last will &
Testament and do ordain Order and dispose of my
Worldly Goods in the following manner & form
Imprimis I order and direct that after my death
my will Be left Wife Elizabeth McDonald have
her Maintenance on my land during her life
or widowhood and also shall have the Benefit of
the house I live in and third part of all my
Moveable Estate I also order that she have her
white piaffe fine Wal and white horse and Sides
Saddle and her Bedes and furniture and allow
my Chasual Coloured Mazz to be continued on my
Plantation for the service of my dear wife Elizabeth
McDonald during her widowhood likewise my
Negro fellow named Dick I leave to my dear
wife during her widowhood.

Item I give and bequeath to my Grandson David Humphreys
Three hundred and Twenty acres of Land more or less
being the Plantation I live upon being entered agreeably
to lease with John Atkinson Entry taken for the County
of Caswell is him and his heirs lawfully Begetton of his
Body for ever also I order and direct that my Negro
Dick be left to work on the Plantation as mentioned above
that to be the Property of David Humphreys when he
arrives to the age of sixteen years to him & his Heirs
Likewise I give to D. David Humphreys one Smooth
Bord Gun Razors Scrop and Bone.

Item I order ^{and desire} that my Stock of Hogs be continued without
being sold for the Support of my family. Unless
it appears to my Executor that there will be sufficient
to support the family and others to spare in which
case I order them that appears to be spared to be sold
and the money arising from such sale shall be
applyed to the use of Raising working tools for the family
Plantation.

Item I order and direct that my Son in Law Hugh
Humphreys shall have Three hundred acres of Land
(more or less) of the tract I purchase of Hugh Mann
on joining this tract I now live on formerly
being a part of the same tract to be laid off by an
East and West line running from Alexander
Lucky's Line.

I then Order and Direct that two thirdes of all my meovable Estate shall be equally Divided between my Daughter Kathrine Hemphill and her Two daughters Novil, Mary Hemphill and Margret Hemphill also all my money in hand and Bonds at Interest save that I give to my Dear wife Elizabeth McDonnel all my Pewter and Pots with the ~~furniture~~ furniture belonging to the Staff (after all my Debts are paid; one third part of all my meovable Estate I give to my Dear wife Elizabeth McDonnel the other two thirds to be equally Divided between my Daughters Catharine Hemphill and her two Daughters apes I also Order and Direct that my Daughter Catharine Hemphill shall have my book title Sisters Patchan

Item I give and bequeath to my sonin law Hugh Hemphill all my body Cloths to be Divided to him after my Deceas. Item I give and bequeath to my Daughter in law Margret Wakefield one bed and furniture two place whiles one chair (and one Reant man) three years old & Side Saddle.

Item I order and Direct that nothing of the flooring of my house where the planks are not laid down be removed.

Lastly I constitute ordain and appoint my Trusty Friends Arch Murphy Esq and John Black Executors to this my Last will & Testament and I do revoke disanul make void all other Wills by me made and Ratify and Confirm

This only to be my last Will & Testament In witness whereof the said Duncan McDonnel has hereunto set my hand and has affixed my Seal the day and year first above written.
