Such, I have said, but be it Revised, and it is my Will, that
 should the said Francis Auerat die and leave no children, that
 then the Negro before sent to her, I order that they be divided equally
 amongst the rest of my children. Item. I give and bequeath to
 my grand son John Moore Auerat, a Negro Child named Sarah
 (daughter of mine) and should the said John Moore Auerat die
 before he has any issue, I order, and it is my Will that the above
 mentioned Negro Sarah shall be divided, according to its value
 amongst the rest of my daughter Francis children, and should
 both my grand son John Moore Auerat, and my daughter Francis
 Auerat die and leave no children, I order the said Negro girl
 and her increase be equally divided amongst my children.

And as for my land lying on Spring Creek I order it to be sold at
 the direction of my Executors, with all the residue of my Estate but be
 it Revised, that should my son John Moore die before he has the said
 land, above mentioned he shall pay to my Estate the sum of thirty pounds
 Virginia money and enjoy the Remainder. And when the residue of my
 Estate is sold and all my Just debts are paid, I do order and desire
 that whatever money is over, and above paying my debts to be equally
 divided amongst my children. Lastly, I do constitute, assign
 and appoint, my beloved son Ephraim Moore, who is my heir at Law,
 and my second son John Moore, my son in law I want lord M'gibbon
 and my Trusty friend Archibald Murphy, sole Executors to this
 my last Will and Testament, and I do hereby Revoke and
 annul, and make void all the Will or Wills by me made
 before.
