I shew unto him & his heirs forever, I give
and bequeth to my daughter Fanny Luther lane one
cow and a cow sparkling one feather bed and one
hundred Acres of land to her and her heirs forever.
I give and bequeth to my daughter Mary Ann
Stringer one young cow and one feather bed to her
and her heirs forever, I give and bequeth
to my granddaughter Sarah Stringer one young cow
to her and her heirs forever and what remains
at my Wife's decease after the legacies receive is
to be Equally divide between my Children Ed-
ward William Stringer Lemuel Stringer
Ignep Whilllock Lucia Brown Tabitha Pearl
Sarah Lambell & my son Edmund Stringer one
Shillinge each & no more I leave to my son
Ruben Stringer one Shilling and no more I also
give to my daughter Frances Clev one Shillinge each
and no more. I constitute and appoint my
said Wife my lawfull Executor of this my last
Will and Testament and I do hereby utterly
revoke and disannull all and every other former
and conforming Will and no other to be my last will
and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
