do warrant and defend the Title of the said Linda free and
Clear from the said claim or claims of me My heirs &
and assigns and from the Just claim of all and every other
Person or Persons holding or claiming the said Linda from or among
him them or any of them to the only proper use and behoof
of him the said James Robertson his heirs &
and assigns forever In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & affixed my seal this 26th day of December
Anno Domⁱ 1785

heirs their heirs & assigns & App^{rs} to the which payment it
will and lawfully to be made as hereinafter appears And we
bind ourselves jointly & severally by these presents sealed with our seals
and dates this 1st day of September Anno Domⁱ 1786

Whereas John Sheppard a Soldier belonging to the 2^d Regiment
of the State of North Carolina in the said Capt. John Summers
Company did while in the service of his Country And whereas
the said Elizabeth Galtrey & Sarah Sheppard are heirs to the said
John Sheppard & are entitled & capable to collect of Gen^l Spotswood
the wages of the said John for his services aforesaid

And of the said Elizabeth Galtrey & Sarah Sheppard their
heirs & App^{rs} shall forever indemnify and save Clear and
Acquiesce the said Moore & Summers against all persons & persons
Whosoever that shall in future pretend to claim the said
wages whether by Herieth or otherwise from the said
Moore & Summers then the above Obligation to be paid
otherwise to remain in full force & Effect
