This Indenture made the 20th day of April 1789 between Stephen Moore Esquire in behalf of the Justices and their Associates of the County of Canada of the one part and John McCulloch of the other part Witness that the said Stephen Moore in pursuance to an Order of the said Court made the day and date above written and according to the direction of the Act of Assembly for that Case made & Proceeded with that plan and kind unto the said John McCulloch Solomon Cooper an Orphan now of the age of six years and two months to be after the manner of an Apprentice the want until he shall attain the age of twenty one years during all which times the said Apprentice his said Master faithfully shall serve his said Master Com mends every where Gladly & Obedy he shall not at any time Absent himself from his said Masters service without leave but in all things as a good and faithful Servant shall behave towards his said Master. And the said John McCulloch with Consent & Promise said agree to and with the said Stephen Moore that he will Teach and Instruct and according to Law to read and Write & also the Art and Mystery of a Blacksmith and that he will Constantly find and Provide for the said Apprentice during the Term of said sufficient and Working Learning and Apparel fitting for an Apprentice and all other things necessary both in Substence and in Health, In Witness whereof the parties have interchangedly set their hands and seals the day and year forth above written
