In the name of God Amen. I Elizabeth Garrison of
 the County of Carroll & State of North Carolina being in
 perfect health of Body and of perfect mind and memory thanks
 be to Almighty God and Calling to mind the mortality of my
 body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to
 die, do make and ordain this my last will & Testament
 that is to say, Principally and first of all I give and recom-
 mend my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave

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I give what I shall hereafter acquire. Finally,
I give to my eldest son William Harrison, and my
son George Harrison, the tract of land I now
have upon, to be divided between them as they can agree
when of age also one acre of land lying on the East
side of the land aforesaid being of John Patterson
time of deceased by law from my brother, also one
acre and all my English land to be divided
between them equally also one tract of land I have
to give to them I have given.

I give to my son John Harrison one
acre of land which I bought of Nathan Piers
at the fork road, also one horse and saddle one
horn & half to him and his heirs forever.

I give to my daughter Elizabeth the above.
Require her and child after my wife's death and her
issue if any to be divided to said daughter when
of age or married, also one saddle and bridle
to her and her heirs forever.

I declare that it is my will and desire that if any of
my children should die before the come of age or mar-
ried, that their part should be equally divided amongst
the living children before married. And I do hereby
constitute make and ordain my wife Jane and her
brother John & his wife, Thomas Barnett Elizabeth
and the whole and able Executors of this my last Will
& Testament, I do hereby declare as above made &
renewed all and more other former Testaments,

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in Will, by me on every way before I died ratify-
ing and confirming them and no other to be my
