Administrators Executors and Assigns the Title of the said Slave Peter and Oblige to the only use benefit and behoof of him his said Heirs and Assigns his Heirs and Assigns free and clear from the said Claim or claims of all and every Person Claiming the same Given under my hand and Seal this 13th day of January 1787
