

211) In the Name of God Amen the 11 day of November 1842
 I Henry Dixon Junr of the County of Caswell and State of North
 Carolina Being of Sound Memory But Proposing to March with
 the Army to South Carolina and leaving to Mend the Maltitude
 of my Body, and knowing that is appointed for all men
 Once to die. do make and Ordain this my Last Will and
 Testament that is to say, Principally and first of all I give and
 Recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave
 it and my Body I commend to the Earth to be Buried in
 Decent and Christian like Burial at the Discretion of my
 Executors not Doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall
 receive the same again by the Mighty Power of God, and as
 Touching last Worthy Estate whereunto I hath Pleas'd God
 to Bless me in this Life I give Devise and Dispose of the
 same in the following Manner To-wit

I Impremise I send to my dearly Beloved Wife Martha my whole
 Estate untill such time as my son Hyman Dixon shall arrive
 to the age of Twenty one years old or Dying her Widowhood
 and if she should not marry I send her the Tract of Land
 now on and a Negro Woman called Hannah Dyeing
 her Natural Wife

Item I give to my Beloved son Hyman Dixon the Tract or parcel
 of Land I bought of William Gresham lying on Johns Branch
 of Hogans Creek in Caswell County & State of North
 Carolina Entered for Six Hundred and forty Acres but is now divided

Item I give to my Beloved son Roger Dixon a Tract or parcel of
 Land lying on Johns Branch in Caswell County North
 Carolina &c. Which there is a Warrant for Six Hundred
 Acres Beginning at Marshall's & Medals South West Corner

Item I give to my Beloved son Robert Dixon a Tract or parcel of
 Land on a Horse Creek in Caswell County North Carolina
 which is Entered for Six Hundred & forty Acres Beginning
 at John Perkins South East Corner

212) Item I give to my Beloved son Henry Dixon after the Death of
 a Marriage of my dearly Beloved Wife the Tract or Parcel of
 Land whereon I now live which is Entered for Six Hundred forty
 Acres Beginning at Samuel Perkins North East Corner

Item I give to my well beloved Daughter Charlotte Dixon and Thomas
 Dixon one her ten Tract or parcel of Land lying on the Waters
 of Rattlesnake Creek on the South side of Dan River between the
 Province line in Fyfe Loane County State of Virginia
 Containing Twelve Hundred & forty Acres to be equally Divided
 Between them

Item it is my Desire that my Children should be Raised in a Decent
 & Christian and Well Educated out of my Estate and that all the
 remainder of my Estate Consisting of several Tracts of Land
 several Slaves Stock of all kind Household Furniture money &c.
 to be Equally Divided Between my dearly Beloved Wife
 and Children or as many of them as shall be living when
 my first son is Twenty one years old and also that the
 Negro Woman Hannah be to my dearly Beloved Wife
 Dyeing her Natural Wife or Widowhood upon her
 Death or Marriage should with her Increase be Equally
 Divided as above

I do Constitute make and Ordain my dearly Beloved
 wife Martha with her Brother Thomas Hyman and Charles
 Dixon my Soul Executors of this my Last Will & Testament
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
 the Day and year above Written
