(144) In the Name of God amen, I Humphrey Donalson of the County of Northumberland & County of Newcastle being Weak in Body but of sound Memory, before God, do this fifth day of August One Thousand Seven Hundred & Eighty one, make & publish this my last Will & Testament in a Manner following, That is to say first I leave and Bequeath to my beloved Wife Mary Donaldson One Bed & Furniture thereof Other & Hair Haddie & her Maintenance on the Land during her Natural life Also I leave and Bequeath to my Daughter Jeanith Donaldson One & Hair of Eighteen Pounds Value, old rates, to receive her when my said Daughter is Twenty one years of age & one less Also, I leave and Bequeath to my Daughter Martha when she arrives to the age of Twenty one years one Hair of Eighteen pounds, old rates of One pound Also, I leave and Bequeath to my Daughter Margaret Donaldson when she arrives to the age of Twenty one years one Hair of Eighteen Pounds Value old rates of One pound Also, I leave and Bequeath to my son William Donaldson One Hundred & Twenty five Acres of Land adjoining William Richmond & James Richmond Land Also, I leave and Bequeath to my son Andrew Donaldson One Hundred & Twenty five Acres of Land Adjoining William Richmond & Elizabeth Coggs Land Also, I leave and Bequeath to my son Robert Donaldson One Hundred & Forty Acres of land lying in the South West corner of my Survey Also, I leave and Bequeath to my son Edinger Donaldson One Hundred & Twenty five Acres of Land Adjoining to Benjamin Haddis's land Also, I leave and Bequeath to my Son Humphrey Donaldson One Hundred & Twenty five Acres of Land including the Improvement thereon Also, I leave and Bequeath to my Daughter Mary Richmond Wife of James Richmond five Shillings

the County of Caswell and province of North Carolina being in
a law State of Health but of Perfect Sense and Memory
Thank to be given to God. Calling to mind the Mortality
of my body and knowing whilst it is affranchised from all mortal
die do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament
That it to say I entirely and first of all give and
commend my soul into the hand of Almighty God that gave
it and my body I commend to the Earth to be buried in
Desert Christian burial at the Discretion of my Executors
Nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall
Receive the same again by the Mighty power of God
and as Touching such worldly Estate wherewithal I

disposse of the same after the following manner Item
First I bind to my well Beloved wife Sarah & Name one

widow and at her Intermarriage I leave the same to be sold
and the Money to be Equally Divided between my son

to my wife During her life and at her Death to be Equally
Divided between my son Joseph and my Daughter Mary
but if my son Joseph Daughter should both die before
