Apprentice & Servant until she attain the Age of Eighteen years
Beginning at which time her said Master she faithfully shall serve
his Lawfull Commands everywhere Gladly Obedy she shall not
at any time Absent herself from her said Masters Service
without Leave but in all things as a Good and faithfull
Servant shall behave Towards Towards her said Master

And the said John Miller doth Covenant Promise and agree to and
with the said James Rice that he will Teach or cause to be Taught
the said Sarah Harrison to Read the Scriptures According to the
and also Teach her to sew to be Taught her the Business of a Spinster
and that he will Constantly feed and Provide for the said Apprentice
During the Term aforesaid Sufficient diet Washing Lodging
and Apparel Sufficient for an Apprentice and all other things
necessary both in sickness and in health the which whereof
the Parties to these presents hath Indorseable at the hands of the

This Indenture Witnesseth that Edward Miller of the
his wife of the County of Caswell hath put her son William a Male
and by their Parents both Voluntary and of their own Accord and free
will put him an apprentice to Samuel Branch of the same County
his Son and Apprentice to serve his Trade or Mystery and after
the Manner of an apprentice to have him from the day of the date
Hereof until he arrive to the age of Twenty one years. During all
which time the said apprentice his said Master faithfully shall
Love his Lords keep his Lawfull command, obey when charged
shall do no Damage to his said Master, nor Let it to be done by
Others without letting or giving notice thereof to his said Master
He shall not waste his said Masters goods, nor lend them
Unlawfully to any, he shall not Commit ~~any~~ Fornication
nor contract Marriage during the said time, at Cards dice
or any other other unlawful games he shall not play unless
his master may be Damaged, with his own goods nor the goods of
Others during the said time without licence from his said Master
He shall not absent himself day nor night from his Masters
Service without his leave nor haunt Ale houses, Taverns or Play
houses but in all things behave himself as a faithfull apprentice
ought to do during the said time, And the said Master shall
use the utmost of his Endeavours to teach or cause to be taught
or Instructed the said apprentice in the Trade or Mystery
he now followeth, and Provide or Provide for him Sufficient
Meat Drink Apparel and Washing fitting for an apprentice during
the said time. And for the due performance shall and may the
said Covenants and agreements Either of the said Parties
bind themselves unto the other by their Parents, In Witness
