Year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety Nine Between
James Sanders Esq^r chairman of the Superior Court of Pleas & Quarter
Sessions of the County of Caswell aforesaid on behalf of the Estates
of the said County Within Sixty Pounds of the one Part N. Frederick Detow
of the other Part Witnesseth, that the said James Sanders Esq^r in
pursuance to an order of the said Court made the 22nd day of this
Instant and according to the direction of the act of our General
Assembly in that case made & provided doth Rent & Bind
unto the said Frederick Detow, Joseph Gibbs, orphan of the age
of six years last May with the said Detow to live after the manner
of an Apprentice Servant until the said Joseph Gibbs apprentice
shall attain to the age of Eighteen years, during all which Time
the said Servant his said Master faithfully shall Serve his
said master command and every where Gladly obey, he shall not at any
Time absent himself from his said Master Service without leave
but in all things as a good & faithful Servant shall behave toward
his said Master & the said Frederick Detow both conveniently, prudently
and Agreeable and with the said James Sanders Esq^r that he will
teach, Instruct or cause to be Taught & Instructed the said Joseph
Gibbs to learn the art of Shoemaker & that he will constantly find
and Provide for the said Apprentice during the term aforesaid sufficient
ditt. Working Lodging & apparel fitting for an Apprentice also all
other things necessary both in Sicknes & in health & Witnes

(9) This Indenture witnesseth that John Garrett of the County of
Caswell Province of North Carolina hath put his son William Garrett & by
his Appentice to voluntarily for his own free will & accord put his son
Appentice to William Glenn of the aforesaid County Whitewright to serve his
Master or Mystery of And after the manner of an Appentice for Valuing
the Term of Nine years from the Thirtieth day of May Next during
all which Term the said Appentice his Master faithfully shall serve his
Said Master, his lawfull commands every where Gladly obey, he shall
do no damage to his said Master nor let it be done by others without
Letting or Giving Notice thereof to his said Master, he shall not Waste his
Said Masters Goods nor lend them unlawfully to any, he shall not com-
mit fornication or Contract Matrimony during the said Term, Cards,
dice, or any other unlawfull game he shall not play, wheroy his said Master
may be damaged, with his own Goods or the Goods of Others, he shall not
depart himself day or Night from his Said Masters Service without his
leave, nor Depart Ale houses, or Taverns, but in all things to behave himself as
a fit & full appentice ought to do during the said Term, & the said Master
Shall do the utmost of Endeavours to teach or cause to be taught or instructed
the said Appentice or Mystery he now followeth & to make & provide sufficient
Meat drink, apparel, Lodging and Working fitting for an Appentice dur-
ing the said Term, if the said Master is to leave the said Appentice to
Read & Write a legible hand, and at the Expiration of his time the said
Appentice is to have such cloathing as is customary in the like cases
and for the due Performance of all his duty the said covenant & Agreement
Written in the other Side Ether of the said parties bind themselves their
Heirs East & West or Assigns unto the other by these Presents Witnesseth
whereof they have Interchangably put their hands & seals this Twenty ninth
day of April One thousand Seven hundred Eighty
