This Indenture made the 22^d day of Sept^r in the
 Year of our Lord One thousand Seven Hundred & Seventy Nine Between
 James Sanders Esq^r Chairman of the Inferior Court of Pleas & Quarter
 Sessions of the County of Caswell State aforesaid on behalf the Justices
 of the said County & their Successors of the one Part & Friedrich Debow
 of the other Part Witnesseth that the said James Sanders Esq^r in
 pursuance to an order of the said Court made the 22^d day of this
 Instant and according to the direction of the act of our General
 Assembly in that case made & provided doth put place & bind
 unto the said Friedrich Debow, Jurath Gimbis, Orphan of the age
 of six years last & may with the said Debow to live after the manner
 of an Apprentice & Servant untill the said Jurath Gimbis Apprentice
 shall attain to the Age of Eighteen years, during all which Time
 the said Servant his said Master faithfully shall serve his
 Lawfull commands every where Gladly Obey, he shall not at any
 Time absent himself from his said Masters Service without leave
 but in all things as aforesaid faithfully Comport shall behave towards
 his said Master & the said Friedrich Debow doth covenant, promise
 and Agree to and with the said James Sanders Esq^r that he will
 teach & Instruct or cause to be taught & instructed the said Jurath
 Gimbis to learn the art of Apprenticeship that he will constantly feed
 and provide for the said Apprentice during the term aforesaid sufficient
 diet & lodging & Apparel fitting for an Apprentice & also all
 other things necessary both in keeping & his health & Welfare
 Whereof the Parties to these Presents have interchangeably set their
 hands & Seals the day & year first above Written

(99) This Indenture Witnesseth that John Garrett of the County of
 Caswell Province of North Carolina hath put his son William Garrett who
 this presents doth voluntarily of his own free will & accord put his son
 Apprentice to William Glean of the aforesaid County who is to learn his
 Trade or Mystery, & And after the manner of an Apprentice for Learning
 the Term of Nine years from the thirtieth day of May Next ensuing
 all which Term the said Apprentice his Master faithfully shall serve his
 Lawfull shall keep his Lawfull commands every where Gladly obey he shall
 do no damage to his said Master nor let it done by others without
 letting or giving Notice thereof to his said Master, he shall not Waste his
 said Masters Goods nor lend them unlawfully to any, he shall not com-
 mit fornication or Contraband Marriage during the said Term, Cards,
 dice or any other unlawfull game he shall not play, whereby his said Master
 may be damaged, with his own Goods or the Goods of others, he shall not
 absent himself day or Night from his said Masters Service without his
 leave nor haunt Ale houses or Taverns, but in all things behave himself as
 a faithful apprentice might to do during the said Term, & the said Master
 shall do the utmost of Endeavours to teach or cause to be taught & instructed
 the said Apprentice or Mystery he now followeth & procure & provide sufficient
 Meat drink Apparel, lodging and Washing fitting for an Apprentice du-
 ring the said Term, & the said Master is to learn the said Apprentice to
 Read & Write a Legible hand, and at the Expiration of his time the said
 Apprentice is to have such cloathing as is customary in the like cases
 and for the due performance of all & every the said covenants & Agreements
 Written in the other Side Copies of the said Parties bind themselves their
 Heirs Executors & Assigns unto the other by these Presents & Witnesses
 whom they have interchangeably put their hands & Seals this Twenty ninth
 day of April One thousand Seven Hundred & Eighty
