This day came John Clayton before me one of the Justices for the said County and made Oath on the Holy Evangelist of Almighty God that John Harris Deceased his Wife the last day of June 1782 and that he when in his proper Senses made this his Verbal Will Viz^t—
I give to my wife Anna Harris all my lands Stock and Household Furniture During her Natural Life and for her to Dispose of it as she pleases &c also
Educate the Clayton Declaration Oath the same Day and Date that she Heard John Harris (Deceased) Say that it was his Desire that his wife should have his Whole Estate to do with Pleased with

This Indenture made this 9th Day of Septem^r Anno Domini 1792 Between John Atkinson Esq^r on the half of his fellow Justices of the Inferior Court of the County of Caswell & then Successors of the One part and James Faragher of the Other Part Witnesseth that the said John Atkinson Esq^r in pursuance to an Order of the said County Court made the 18th Day of June 1791 and according to the Decision of our General Assembly on that case made and Provided Both part place and Bound unto the said James Faragher

218 Thomas Price an orphan Boy of the age of ten years & his father with the said James Faragher taken after the manner of an Apprentice and bound until he Attain the age of Twenty one year During all which time his said Master he lawfully shall have his Lawfull Command and may where Gladly Obey he shall not at any time Absent himself from his said Master, living without leave first in all things as a good and Lawful Servant Behave Towards his said Master and the said James Faragher doth Covenant promise and agree and with the said John Atkinson that he will Teach and Instruct and cause to be Taught and Instructed the said Thomas Price to Read Write and Cypher according to Law and also Instruct Instruct him in the Business of a planter & that he will constantly send and provide for the said apprentice Sufficient Diet Washing and Lodging and Apparels During the Term above said getting for in Appreniceship also all other things necessary both in business and in Health In Witness where of the Parties to these Presents have Interchangeably set their hands and seals the Day and year first above Written
