that kind & some Seed and Stock of all kind and household
and kind such as I am possessed with & I do put in my will
That she and the issue of the above mentioned Estate as she shall see
and my Desire is that my son in law John Papley shall assist
my wife Sarah Papley in the Management of the above Estate
that I give to her Now I do appoint my Beloved Wife Sarah
Papley my sole and true Executor with my son in law John Papley
to her assistance in everything whereof I have set my hand and seal

in his possession also Ten Pounds Currency no more
To my Daughter Ann Wife to James Christie I give & Bequeath
Twenty Pounds Currency no more
To my Wellbeloved Wife Mary I give and Bequeath my bay mare
& the Choice of above and Calf out of my Stock her Saddle
Bridle &c & a Reasonable Maintenance off my Land
her Wearing clothes & Bed & Furniture & House Furnishing
N.B. Her Riding Saddle & Wearing clothes to her then disposed of
