William Williams of the County of Caswell and State of North Carolina
being sick in body but of perfect and sound mind and memory thanks
be given to God for the same and bethinking to mind the uncertainty of this
life do make this my Last Will and Testament in the following manner
First I Give and Bequeath to my son John Williams
part of my Land to be laid off as follows, Beginning on the branch where
I live & extend to the Fence dividing his field and mine thence
Running up the dividing fence between Caswell & Robeson
County at the upper end said Fence, thence a direct course to a
Sandy corner of my Land on the head of the cutting branch
thence Eastward with my line until it comes to said branch
from whence it first began, thence up the branch to the beginning
to him during his Natural Life and at his Death to his
Daughter Priscilla — Second I Give to my Daughter Mary
Williams all the remaining part of my Land on the North side
of the above mentioned branch whereon I live to be at her
sole disposal forever — Thirdly I Give and bequeath to my
Daughters Agnes Williams & Abigail Williams the remaining
part of my Land being all on the South side of the above
mentioned branch to be Equally divided between my Executors
Lastly I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Mary Williams above named
and also to Agnes Williams daughter of Abigail Williams (now born) the whole
of my Personal Estate remaining after my Just Debts and funeral
charges are paid and it is my Will that in dividing the same that my
wid be paid in the full Given to said Agnes &c And the hereby appoint
my Trusty Friends John Campbell and William Henry Executors of
this my Last Will and Testament Respecting and making void all
former Wills by me made and do constitute Ordain and appoint this
my Last and Testament
