Giving Granting and my said Attorney by these presents my full Power and Authority to take Receipts and receiving and Obtaining of the same as if I myself might or could do. were I personally present. Ratifying Confirming and allowing all and whatsoever my Attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done therein by virtue of these presents.
