 Rachel surviving for Widowhood and after her Marriage or Decese
 to be equally Divided between my sons Mr. Elisha Perkins
 Perkins, And to my son James Perkins I Give one Cow & Calf
 and which Witnesseth the same I have hereunto set my hand
 and Seal this day and date above written

It is further my Will that my Daughter Jane & Maxwell shall
have 1 Negro Woman named Patience I also constitute make
and Ordain Henry & Wilson the Sole Executor of this my last
Will and Testament. I do hereby dissolve of all other Wills
Legacies & ratifying and confirming this and as other to be
my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & Seal this 26th day of May and in the year
of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and ninety one

Item I Give to my beloved wife Ann Lee during her life one third part of my estate Nevertheless After the life of Desire that my beloved wife Ann Lee retain in her hands the whole of my Estate real and personal during her Widowhood

Item I Give to my beloved Daughter Mary Burgeson two thirds over and above what she has in her hands to be paid to her by my Executors as soon as it can be after my Decease when her Heir and Heirs forever

Item I Give to my three beloved sons Vincent Henry & George the whole of my Land to be equally divided between them also an equal part of my personal Estate to them their Heirs & Heirs forever

Item I Give to my beloved Daughters Richard Sarah Lee an equal part of my personal Estate to them their Heirs & Heirs forever

Also if my beloved Wife Ann Lee remains unmarried till any part or all of my Children arrive to Age I Desire that my Executors pay them their Portion as they come of age or change their Mind that if any of my Children die before they come of age that their parts be equally divided among the living as it is Willed I also do by these Presents make constitute and appoint my Trusty Friends Moses Brasher and Carter Lee my Executors to whom I commit my whole affairs to be handled and receive and receive all and every other former Testaments Wills and Legacies & Benefices and confirming this and no other to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this the 28th September 1791

Speaks to Order of the Worshipful Court for the County of Caswell in October 1791 for the purpose of making an Equal division of the Estate of Josiah Farley Dec. Between Sarah Johnston & Elizabeth Farley, & Mother & Sister of the said Josiah Farley Dec.

We the Subscribers nominated for the purpose aforesaid on examination find that seven young Negroes the Children of a certain Negro Woman named Phill, Belonging Equally to the Estate of Josiah Farley Dec. and his Sister the aforesaid Elizabeth Farley And that two of the seven young Negroes, Stephen & Matt and as near as may be one fourth part of the Value of the seven young Negroes to wit Lewis Bill Stephen, Lucy Mary Matt, & Frank and consequently belongs to Sarah Johnston as being Equal to one half of the Value of said Josiah's Interest in said seven young Negroes that the other four, to wit, Lewis Bill Lucy Mary and Frank belongs to Elizabeth Farley now Beutler Including said Elizabeth's Morality of Interest in said seven young Negroes and half the Interest of Josiah Dec.
