¶ Matthew Duty of Caswell County and State of North Carolina do make Ordain and Constitute this my last Will and Testament. Item I Will and Bequeath unto my Beloved son William Duty my Sonett & one Cow and Calf, one Sow and Piggs and Three Hundred lbs of Pick at the fall to be made out of the Stock of Hogs also six Pounds in money Item I Will unto my Beloved son Solomon Duty one Bay Horse I bought of Richardson Queen one Cow and Calf when he may come to the age of Twenty one years and until then to remain on the Plantation for the use same Item I Will unto my Beloved son Richard Duty one White Horse one Cow and Calf when he may come to the age of Twenty one years and until then to remain on the Plantation for the use of the same Item I Will unto my Beloved Grandson William Queen one Sow & Calf

also on his Hogs and Calf Item I Will that Twenty  
six Shillings be made into four Pounds one far my Beloved  
Wife and each of my Daughters Sarah Queen Mary Duty  
and Ann Duty Item I Will and Bequeath unto my  
Beloved Wife one Third Part of my Land Deneing her  
Natural life I Will that all Debts Due me be Collected  
as soon as Possible and all Lawfull Demands Discharged  
Then the余 Balance with the Malance of Cash or Bonds  
to be laid out to the Best Advantage in one or more  
Certificates the Remainder of my Estate Both Real and Personal  
I Will unto my Beloved wife for the use of Deneing her  
and Learning my young Children until my son Thomas  
Duty come to the age of Twenty one years of the Name  
Otherwise to be Taken away and Taken care of by the Testator  
and be it as it may when my son Thomas comes to the age  
of Twenty one years I Will that my lands be sold and the  
Proceeds with a Negroe or Negress and the remainder  
of Stock of all Kinds Household Goods of Furniture be  
Valued or Praised and I Will that each of my sons  
John Duty, Littleton Duty, and Thomas Duty to have  
Twenty pounds each and I Will that my Daughter Mary  
Duty and Ann Duty to have Six Pounds each and  
I Will that the Remainder be equally Divided among  
my son William Duty, Solomon Duty, Richard Duty, the  
Duty Littleton Duty, Thomas Duty, and my Daughters  
Mary Duty, and Ann Duty, and Lastly I will appoint  
my Beloved son William Duty, my Trusty Friend John  
Adams and Charles Littleton my sole Executors to this  
my last Will and Testament the Witness whereof I have  
hereunto set my hand and seal affix my seal in presence  
of Richardson Queen
