 Ordain & appoint this my last will & Testament in Manner
 and form following Recording by these Presents all Wills
 and Testaments either made or Relained by me either by word
 or Writing this is to be Taken only for my last will &
 Testament and none Other & I Recommend my Soul into
 the Hands of Almighty God that gave it & my Body to the
 Earth from whence it came & Now for the Settling of my
 Temporal Estate & such Goods Chattels & Cests as I have
 pleased God for above my Children to bestow upon me I
 do here Give and Dispose the Same in Manner & form
 following, That is to say first I Will that all my Just
 Debts be Paid by my Executors hereafter named
 Item I Give & Bequeath to my beloved Wife Darius Harrison
 a Negro Girl named Figg, & her Increase to her & her Heirs for
 ever — Item I Give & Bequeath to my Daughter Mary
 Smith my Black Slave & her Increase to her & her Heirs for ever
 Item I Give and Bequeath to my four Sons, Thomas, Tobias,
 Nathan & Amosiah all the Lands that I possess, to be equally
 Divided between them in Quantity & Quality, & if either die
 before they come to years Age their Part to be Equally
 Divided among the Rest — Item I Give & Bequeath to
 my Daughter Mary Smith one red White Head'd Horse
 and her Increase to her and her Heirs for ever
 Item that my Negro Boy, Allick with the Moveables
 part of my Estate remain with my beloved Wife Darius
 to Raise my Children upon, and the Negro Allick to
 be Equally Divided between my Daughters Elizabeth
 and Sarah & the rest of the moveables to be Equally
 Divided

134) Divided between my Children, Thomas, Tobias, Nathan
 Amosiah, Elizabeth & Sarah, & her Heirs by Inpower
 of my beloved Wife Darius to Give any Part of said Move-
 ables to my children as they & Mary or Come of Age
 according to their Parts, and if my Wife Darius should
 Survive and my Estate like to be Wasted, then that the
 Moveables to be Taken out of her hands only her Third
 I give her, And my will is that my beloved Wife
 Darius hold the Plantation I Now in with as much
 of my New surveyed Land adjoining the Same as will
 include a Water Spring near Graves's Line
 And I do hereby constitute & Appoint my beloved
 Wife Darius, Harrison my Son Thomas Harrison
 my Executors with my hand this 7 day of April 1782
