Two Hundred and Eighty two Acres of Land lying on both sides of Hogans Creek including the Plantation whereon I now live with one Hundred Acres I purchased of Peter Smith and One Hundred Acres adjoining said John Burtons Land to have and to hold the said Bargained Premises unto the said Lancelotte Johnston his heirs Ex^{ts} &c. to use and to hold the said Bargained Premises unto the said Lancelotte Johnston his heirs Ex^{ts} &c. for the only proper use and behoof of the said Lancelotte Johnston his heirs Ex^{ts} &c. Adm^{rs} &c. I Alice Tury for myself my heirs Ex^{ts} &c. Administrators the said Bargained premises unto the said Lancelotte Johnston his heirs Ex^{ts} &c. Administrators and assigns against all and all manner of Persons shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. Provided nevertheless that if the said Alice Tury my heirs Ex^{ts} &c. Administrators or assigns shall will or lawfully pay or cause to be paid unto the said Lancelotte Johnston his heirs Ex^{ts} &c.
