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Robert Johnston's Will

State of North Carolina, Caswell County, In the Name of god Al-
mighty I Robert Johnston of the County and State aforesaid being well and
of a sound Memory Blessed be god, do this 12th day of August
year of our Lord 1783 make and Publish this my Last Will and
Testament hereby setting Aside all former Wills or Wills made for me
or of the same or Either of them same has never been made, I do
Give up my Soul to Almighty god and my body to a Decent Burial
Hurry and Wholly at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named
in a Christian like Manner, my Will and Pleasure is to give to my
Wife, John, Robert, George, Benjamin, Philip and my
Elizabeth In and Judith Wake Five Shillings Sterling to them a
Vine forever in full of there and Each of those parts of my Estate
I do hereby bequeath unto my beloved wife Francis Pennington Natural
a her Widowhood state every thing and things which I have
after Either of which, that then the whole of my Estate to be Equally
Divided between my Other Children Viz Lucy, Phebe, Dor-
Salley, Abigail, Hampton, Phanny Hampton, my Sons and the
Whom I now live only Excepted what said land I hereby give to
Richard which is his part to him and his heirs forever the then
my Estate to the aforesaid Children to them and
theirs forever, but in Case my wife aforesaid should die
away or Parting any part of my said Estate to
