This Indenture made the 22^d day of July Anno.
Dom^t. 1788. Between Robert Paine Esq^r in behalf of the Justices
and their Surepors of the County Court of Caswell of the one
part and William Reed of the other part witnesseth that
the said Robert Paine in pursuance to an Order of the said
Court made the day & date above written and according to the
directions of the Act of our Gen^t Assembly in such case made and
provided doth put, train and bind unto the said William Reed
James B. Wills an orphan now of the age of six years and
six months. With the said William Reed to live after the
manners of an apprentice Servant until he shall attain to
the age of Twenty One years. During all which time his said
Apprentice his said Master faithfully shall serve his lawful
commandments where gladly obey. He shall not at any time
abstain himself from his said Master service without leave
but in all things as a good and faithful Servant shall behave
towards his said Master. And the said William Reed doth
Covenant promise and Agree to and with the said Rob^t Paine
that he will teach & instruct or cause to be taught to his said
Apprentice James B. Wills to read Write & Cypkin according to
said Rob^t Paine and Master of apprentices. And that he
will constantly find and provide for the said Apprentice
during the term above sufficient diet washing Lodging
and apparel fitting for an Apprentice and all other things
necessary both in sickness and in health. In witness

Other part Witnesbeth. That the said David Shetton in pursuance
to an Order of the said County Court made the day & date of this
present. And according to the directions of the act of our Gen^t Assembly
in such case made & provided. Doth put, train and bind unto the
said John Gately, Judith Bush an orphan now of the age of
One year and six months. With the said John Gately to live after
the manner of an Apprentice and Servant until she shall attain
to the age of Eighteen years. During all which time her said master
faithfully shall serve His lawfull commandments every where gladly obey
She shall not at any time absent herself from her said Master
Leave without leave but in all things as a good and faithful
Servant shall behave towards her said Master. And the said John
Gately doth covenant promise and Agree to and with the said David
Shetton that he will teach & instruct or cause to be taught & instructed
the said Judith Bush to read &c. According to law. And also all
other things necessary both in sickness & in health. That he
will constantly find and provide for the said Apprentice
during the term above sufficient diet washing Lodging & apparel
fitting for an Apprentice & Wm^r McPherson the Partner to whom
present hath interchangably set these hands the day & year
first above written
