Between Robert Cairns Esq^r in behalf of the Justices and their Successors of the County Court of Caswell of the one part and William Reid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Robert Cairns in pursuance to an Order of the said Court made the day & date above written and according to the directions of the Act of our Gen^l Assembly in such case made and provided doth put place and bind unto the said William Reid James B. With an orphan now of the Age of five years and six months. With the said William Reid to live after the manner of an Apprentice & Servant until he shall attain to the Age of Twenty One years. During all which time the said Apprentice his said Master faithfully shall serve his lawful Commands every where gladly obey. He shall not at any time absent himself from his said Master's service without leave but in all things as a good and faithful servant shall behave towards his said Master. And the said William Reid doth Covenant promise and Agree to and With the said Rob^t Cairns that he will teach & instruct or cause to be taught & instructed the said James B. With to read Writ^{ts} & Cypher according to said Act the Art and Mystery of apothecary. And that he will constantly find and provide for the said Apprentice during the Term above sufficient diet washing lodging and Apparel fitting for an Apprentice, And all other things necessary both in sickness and in health. Between David Skelton Esq^r in behalf of the Justices their Successors of the County Court of Caswell of the one part & John Gately of the other part Witnesseth that the said David Skelton in pursuance to an Order of the said County Court made the day & date of these presents. And according to the directions of the act of our Gen^l Assembly in such case made & provided doth put place and bind unto the said John Gately Judith Bush an orphan now of the Age of One year and Six months. With the said John Gately to live after the manner of an Apprentice and Servant until she shall attain to the Age of Eighteen years. During all which time the said master faithfully shall serve his lawful commands every where gladly obey. He shall not at any time absent himself from his said Master's service without leave but in all things as a good and faithful servant shall behave towards her said Master. And the said John Gately doth Covenant promise and Agree to and with the said David Skelton that he will teach & instruct or cause to be taught & instructed the said Judith Bush to read &c. according to law. And also all other things necessary both in sickness & in health & that he will constantly find and provide for the said Apprentice during the term above said sufficient diet washing lodging & Apparel fitting for an Apprentice.
