Know all men by these presents that I Robert M<sup>r</sup> Plaster, of the County of Chowell and State of North Carolina for and on Behalf of Five Persons Whose Names Sitings, to me made on or before the sealing and Signing of these presents by Nicholas Delore a Merchant of the same County and State, herewithin whereof I do hereby acknowledge, Have Granted sold and Delivered and by these presents do fully truly and Absolutely bargain sell Alién and conform unto the said Delore one Bay a Slave heretofore Purchased by me of John Mendenhall and Supposed to be eight years old this Thirtieth past and further agreed to Warrant and Defend the Title in said Slave to the said Delore against the Lawfull claim or Demand of any Person or Persons whatsoever In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this third day of December, A.D. 1794.
