And the said John Miller doth Covenant Promise and agree to and with the said James Rice that he will Teach or cause to be Taught the said Sarah Harrison to Read the Scriptures According to the and also Teach or cause to be Taught her the Principles of a Christian and that he will Constantly Find and Provide for the said Apprentice during the Term aforesaid Sufficient diet Washings Lodging and Apparel Sufficient for an Apprentice and all other things necessary both in sickness and in health the Wherewithal of the Parties to this Indenture both Interchangeably let the hands of the said James Rice Esq^r and John Miller be put to the day and year first above Written

This Indenture Witnesseth that Edward Appleton & Anne his wife of the County of Caswell hath put her son William Appleton a Male and by these Presents doth Voluntary and of their own Accord and free will put him an Apprentice to Samuel Boncher of the same County his Son and Assigns & Sonner to learn his Trade or Mystery and after the manner of an Apprentice to serve him from the day of the date Hereof until he arrive to the age of Twenty one years During all which time the said Apprentice his said Master faithfully shall Love his Love keep his Lawfull Command every where Obedy he shall do no Damage to his said Master nor Let it to be done by Others without letting or giving notice thereof to his said Master He shall not waste his said Masters goods nor lend them Voluntarily to any he shall not Commit Fornication nor contract Marriage during the said time at Courts die or any other other unlawful games he shall not play whereby his Master may be Damaged with his own goods nor the goods of Others during the said time nor steal Linnen from his said Master He shall not absent himself day nor night from his Masters Service without his leave nor haunt Ale houses Taverns or Play houses but in all things behave himself as a faithfull apprentice ought to do during the said time And the said Master shall use the utmost of his Endeavours to teach or cause to be taught or Instructed the said Apprentice in the Trade or Mystery he now followeth and Provide or Provide for him sufficient Meat Drink Apparel and Washing letting for an apprentice during the said time And for the due Performance shall and carry the said Covenants and agreements both of the said Parties bind themselves unto the other by these Presents In Witness whereof They have interchangeably put their hands at the
