In case all men by these presents that use Thomas Brooks Thomas Rice Esq^r Benjamin Benjamin Williamson John Brown Daniel William Vance Bailey and James Williamson Esquires all of the County of Caswell and State of North Carolina are held and firmly bound unto his Excellency Alexander Martin Esquire Gov. of the said State of North Carolina Two Thousand Pounds to be paid unto the said Alexander Martin Esquire Gov. and his Successors and Assigns To the which Payment is well and truly to be made we bind ourselves Our Heirs Our Executors and Administrators Jointly Severally and by their Privy Seals with our Seals Dated this 18th day of October Anno Dom. 1790

The Condition of this Obligation is such that Whereas the above bounden Thomas Brooks is by law appointed Treasurer for the County of Caswell & Therefore the said Thomas Brooks shall well and truly account for and pay unto the Treasurer of the State aforesaid in such Public Taxes as shall be Collected from the Inhabitants of the County of Caswell for the year 1790. at such times and in such manner as the Law Directs also such Other Sums as are Collected and paid him according to Law, after Deducting such Lawful Commissions therefrom and such Indemnity as shall be allowed by the Court of the County aforesaid then the above Obligation shall be void Otherwise to remain in full force & Effect.
