In the Name of God Amen This faith day of September Eighty
 Six I the Sheriff of the County of Leamouth and State of North
 Carolina being sick and Weak but of perfect and sound mind
 Memory do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament
 in manner and form following. First and foremostly I
 Commend my Soul to God who gave it. Hoping to receive
 Pardon for my sins through the Merits of Mediation
 of my Saviour Jesus Christ and my body to the Earth to be
 decently buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter
 mentioned, Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter
 Nancy Abbe, the sum of five Shillings only
 they having already received their share of my Estate
 Item I Give and bequeath to my Daughter Francis Dabney
 wife to Cornelius Dabney the sum of Five Shillings only
 they having already received their share of my Estate in
 Item I Give to my son James Hamilton all the Lands that I possess
 in the County of Leamouth seven Hundred Acres more or less
 to him and his heirs forever, Item, I Give to my two sons
 Simpson Hamilton & Robert Hamilton one Part of Land in the
 County of Rockingham containing five Hundred and
 fifty Acres more or less to be Equally divided between them
 the North and east side of the Creek, Little Troublesome
 to my son Robert and the South and West side of said Creek
 to my son Simpson and also, I Give to my son Robert
 one Hundred Pounds in cash to him and his heirs forever
 Item, I Give to my son Christopher Hamilton one Part of Land
 on High Rock Creek, in the County of Rockingham containing
 five Hundred & forty Acres, to him and his heirs forever, which
 Land is to be sold to the highest bidder, at Two years next
 after the Money paid to interest at the Executors may think
 to my said son Christopher Advantage
