S. Parley afore Named as here by Bargain and sell the above Named Negro Woman Lucy of a Black Complexion and about Twenty one or Twenty two years of age to him and his heirs forever without any Manner of Challenge Claim or Demand of me the said Stuart Parley or any Other Person or Persons in my Name by my Means Consent or Procurement to be the above Named Dan. S. Parley right & Title at the Death of the above Named Mary Parley (Widow) of the above Named John Parley Decd. In Witness Whereof I have here unto set my hand & Seal the 17th day of July 1786.
