to the Records of the 1st of our Genl. Assembly in that case
made provided cloth Rat. Place and bind unto the said Job Siddle
James Owen Watts an orphan Slave of the age of Eight years and
six Months untill he shall attain to the Age of Twenty One years
during all which time the said Apprentice his Master shall fully
shall have his lawful Command away where Glad to Obey he shall
not at any time Absent himself from his said Master's service without
leave but in all things as a good and faithful servant shall
behave towards his said Master and the said Job Siddle cloth
Covenant promise and agree to and with the said Stephen Elmore
that he will Teach said Indent and cause to be Taught and
Instructed according to Law the said James Owen Watts all upon
Clothes also to Mrs Wright &c and that he will constantly find
and provide for the said Apprentice during the term aforesaid sufficient
Diet Washing Lodging and Apparell fitting for an Apprentice &c
Forward and also all other things necessary both on land and
and in Sea. I Witness whereof the parties to these presents have
