of Body but of Sound mind & Memory, DO this Twentieth
day of April in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven
Hundred & Eighty one, Make this my Last will & Testament
in Manner following —

First, I Give unto my Loving Wife Ann, the use of all my personal
Estate during her life or Widowhood —

Item, I Give unto my son Thomas a Tract of Land lying on
Sandover Creek, containing Two Hundred acres, which said
I Bought of my son John, & My Desire is that my said
son John do make a right of said Land to my son Thomas —

Item I Give unto my son Benjamin one Hundred & Fifty acres
of Land joining the Line of a Tract of Land my son John
Land to him this Mine for ever —

Item, I Give unto my Daughter Mary one Hundred acres of
Land lying on Neelys Creek, joining William Vannillion
Line to her this Mine for ever —

Item, It is my Will and Desire that at the Death of my Loving
Wife, that my sons Thomas & Benjamin have each of them
a House & a stable & a Bed, which House are to be of the value
of Ten pounds in Silver, also all the Plantation working
Tools, I desire may be Equally Divided between them —

Item, I further Give unto my Daughter Mary one feather Bed
and furniture & two cows & Calves after the Death of my
Loving Wife —

Item It is my Desire that all my Negroes & their Increase after the Death
or Marriage of my Loving Wife be by Three Honest men Equally
Divided amongst my Eight Children (or the Survivors of them)
To wit, John Thomas Benjamin Elizabeth Robert Mary Vannillion
& Mary Caley Hubbard & I Give to them & their Heirs for ever —

Item all the Remainder of my Estate I Give unto my Two
Daughters Patsy Hubbard & I Give to be Equally Divided between
them by their Good & then to themselves & their Heirs for ever —

Lastly, I do Nominate and appoint my Loving Wife Ann
my son John my son in law William Vannillion & George
Lee (son of William) Executors of this my Last will &
Testament & nothing all other wills by me made In
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
Seal the Day and year above Written
