Sense and Memory do Commit my body to the Earth and
my Soul to God that good it

I give and Bequeath to my Two Youngest sons & Clark
Robertson & Alexander the land Where I now live
to be Equally Divided between the Two having
Fifty acres to my son Thomas Robertson living on
the East Side Joining John Anthony Lewis and
John Robertson line — I Will and Bequeath
to my Daughter Easter One Cow and Yearling
and Calf of my Mare Called poll — I Bequeath to
my son Alexander Robertson one Bay Calf named
James — also to my Son & Clark Robertson one
Pean Horse Four years old — I will and bequeath to
Robert Anderson one Bay Horse — Item I Will and
Bequeath to my Daughter Jimena Pences one sow and
Piggs and a Ewe and Lamb — Item to my son Thomas
Anderson one Cow Piggy with Calf and I give to my wife
all the Rest of my Estate to Raise my Children on
and to Remain with her as long as she remains a
Widow and if she die one Marries again my Wife shall
all that is left may all Return to be Equally divided
among all my Children — I appoint my son John
Robertson & Thomas my Executors.

the County of Carroll and State of South Carolina being sick
and weak of body but of sound Mind and Memory —

I Do Make Constitute ordain and appoint this my last will
and Testament in the following manner and form —

I item I Owe and Devise that my Last Will be punctually paid
by my Executor — Item, I Owe and Devise that my well beloved
Wife Elizabeth Marshall shall have my Two Negro Girls Seta and
Molly to her and her heirs forever — I further Owe that if my
Wife shall be with child by me that it shall have the residue of
my Estate both real and Personal on the Death or Marriage of my
said Wife, and in case my said wife is not with child by me
at this Time and after my Death shall have another son or
and have children, I Owe that the said Estate which I have
Divided to my own Child (in case it had been) Shall be for
her Children for ever, & In case She shall die without Issue
Item, I Owe and Devise that my Estate Shall be Equally divided
Between Nancy Park and Elizabeth Park orphans of William
Park late of White County, Dates

And truly, I Constitute ordain and appoint my Neighbour
Wife Elizabeth Marshall Executrix and my Trusty and well beloved
Friends Archibald Murphy & Josiah Cole Esq^r Executors
to this my last will and Testament and I do hereby revoke and
Disannul all other Wills by me made, Ratifying and Confirming
this only to be my last will and Testament With Me
Whereof I have hereunto set my hand Seal the day & year, and
