Thomas Robertson being in a low State of Health but in perfect Sense and Memory do Commit my body to the Earth and my Soul to God that goes it

I Will and bequeath to my Two Youngest sons Mark Robertson & Alexander the land Wheron I now live to be Equally Divided between the Two Excepting fifty Acres to my son Thomas Robertson lying on the East Side joining John Anthonys land and John Robertsons line - I Will and bequeath to my Daughter Easter One Cow and Yearling and half of my Mare Called Jell - I Bequeath to my son Alexander Robertson one Bay Colt Called James - also to my Son Mark Robertson one

Deer Horse four years old - I Will and bequeath to Robert & Anderson one Bay Horse I Will and bequeath to my Daughter Simona Spence one Cow and Piggs and 1 Cow and Lamb, I Give to my son Thomas Anderson one Cow Begg with Colt and I Give to my wife all the Part of my Estate to Raise my Children on and to Remain with her as long as she remains a Widow and if she dies or Marries again my Will is that all that is all may all Return to be Equally divided among all my Children - I Appoint my son John Robertson & Thomas my Executors.

In the name of God Amen this 17th day of January one Thousand seven Hundred and Eighty two I Claud Murhead of the County of Carroll and State of North Carolina being sick and weak of body but of Sound Mind and Memory Do Make Constitute ordain and appoint this my last will and Testament in the following manner and form -

I Order and Devise that all my Just Debt be punctually paid by my Executors - I Order and Devise that my well beloved Wife Elizabeth Murhead shall have my Two Negro Girls Liza and Molly to her and her Heirs for ever - I further Order that if my Wife shall be with child by me that it shall have the residue of my Estate both real and Personal on the Death or Marriage of my said Wife, and in case my said wife is not with child before at this Time and after my Death shall have another son and have Children, I Order that the said Estate which I have Devise to my own Child (in case it had been) shall be for her Children for ever, & In case she shall die without lawful Issue, I Order and Devise that my Estate shall be Equally divided between Fanny Park and Elizabeth Park orphans of William Park late of Butte County, ^{Deceased}

And lastly, I Constitute ordain and appoint my Well beloved Wife Elizabeth Murhead Executrix and my Party and well beloved Friends Archibald & Murphy & John & John Esqrs Executors to this my last will and Testament and I do hereby revoke and Disannul all other Wills by me made, Ratifying and Confirming this only to be my last will and Testament ^{of my} **Witness** Whereof I have humbly Set my hand & Seal this day & year first above written
