 knowing the Mortality of my body, do Make Constituted and Ordain,
 I appoint this only to be my last Will and Testament and do Order
 and Dispose of my Estate in the Following Manner and Form, Viz^t
 I give and it is my Will and I allow that my last beloved
 Son William Stuart son of James Stuart one young Horse and Saddle, one
 Cow to my well beloved Elisabeth Stuart one Cow to my well beloved
 Rachel Stuart ^{one Cow} to my well beloved Daughter Agnes Stuart one Cow, to my
 Well beloved son James Stuart one young Horse and Saddle
 I give and bequeath to my Son Agnes Stuart His and bequeath all
 the Rest of my personal Estate likewise my land here to wit
 to be the Children or, and After her Death to be sold and Equally
 Divided between my Wife Elizabeth Stuart, William Stuart Elisabeth
 Stuart, Rachel Stuart Agnes Stuart James Stuart and my
 Constable Order and Appoint my loving wife Agnes Stuart and Corde
 and Robert Moore my Executors to this my Last Will and Testament
 fully Reading and Making Good all Other Wills or Wills by me
 Made and do Ratify and Confirm this Only to be my Last Will and
 Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the
 day and year first above Written

Thomas Robinson of the County of Carroll and State of North Carolina being and
 but of sound Mind and Memory and having to Mind Solvency of our Senses and
 that all that is Mental but the Sense thereof being Concealed from us do
 Make this my Last Will and Testament in Manner and Form Following
 (That is to say) In the first place I bequeath my Soul to Almighty God in
 and through the Merits of Jesus Christ my Saviour hoping there in to be
 Received into the Mercies of Eternal Happiness there to abide forever
 and ever and my body to be decently Buried at the Discretion of my
 hereafter Mentioned
 I give and unto my beloved Wife Priscilla Robinson all my personal
 Estate for her use and the Support of her and the Children during her
 Natural Life or as long as she shall remain a Widow and then
 the said Estate to Return as follows To wit I Give to my young
 son the Provision which I now live to be taken by a straight Line from
 Charles Reattors line Beginning at a Stake Emptily known by the Name of the
 Marys Stake and Running a straight Course South till it comes to James
 Kalls line then I Give to my Son Robinson my eldest son all the land
 that lies between Sarahs line and Johns line to the said James
 and so to them and their Heirs forever then I Give to my Son
 that that Piece of Land lying along the Mine branch bounded by the
 Part line containing about One Hundred Acres upon Moore, be sold by
 my Executors for the use and behoof of my Family then it is my Will and
 Pleasure that all my personal Estate and household Furniture be Equally
 Divided amongst my Girls viz^t Nancy Pally, Resiah, Rebecca, Priscilla
 Robinson and also the Negro which Name will be sold on the same day
 they shall be able to add the Money Equally Divided amongst the
 before Mentioned then it is my Will that all Debts due to me after my
 my Executors Debts are paid either by hand Upon me or any otherwise be made
 by my Executors and the Money be Equally Divided amongst my Daughters
 before Mentioned then I constitute and appoint my wife Priscilla Robinson and
 Joseph Tolbert Executors to this my Last Will and Testament Revoking and annulling all
 other Wills or Testaments made or to be made by me in any other place or
 in any State including the State here of in North Carolina whereof I have been and
 am now a Citizen and do hereby certify that this Will of mine was made and
 signed by me this 17th day of May in the year one thousand seven hundred and
 eighty three
