the Shortness & Uncertainty of this Transitory life and that it is app-
for all men Once to die, do make and Ordain this my last will
and Testament in a manner and form following (that is to say)
Principally and first of all I Give and recommend my soul into
the hands of God that gave all; And as for my Body Remains in
to the earth to be Buried in a Christian like and Decent Manner
at the discretion of my Executors nothing Doubting but at the
General Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty
power of God, and as Touching such worldly goods wherewith
it has pleased God to Bless me with in this life, I Give, Devise
& dispose of the Same in a manner and form following, that
is to say, Item, I Give and Bequeath to my wellbelov'd son
John Spencer Two hundred acres of Land to be Taken off that
Corner of the Tract of Land wherupon I live that Joynes Rowland
Hughes, not Touching my Plantation nor a Mill

Item, I Give and Bequeath to my wellbelov'd Daughter
Priscilla Spencer my Bay mare named Fly, (But the
Cott that she is now with sold with to be left on the Plantation
being accepted to dispose of otherwise) one Feather Bed and
Furniture one Cow & one Black walnut chest & one Sides
Saddle

Item, I Give and Bequeath to my wellbelov'd Daughter Betty Spencer
one year old mare Colt that came out of my Bay mare called
Fly, one woman's Saddle one Feather Bed and Furniture, one Cow
and one Black walnut Chest

Item, I Give and Bequeath to my wellbelov'd Daughter Nancy
Spencer one Rear & Mare and one Cow that she already has in possession
and likewise one Bed & Chest that she has in possession & one woman's
Saddle that she has not yet Received

Item, I Give and Bequeath to my wellbelov'd Daughter Mary
Spencer one Bay horse (Cott) that came out of my Wids mare
one Woman's Saddle, one Feather Bed & Furniture, one Cow and
one Black walnut Chest

(Wit) Item, I Give and Bequeath to my wellbelov'd Daughter
Susannah Spencer one Bay Horse Cott, that is called her own
Woman's Saddle one Feather Bed and Furniture, one Cow & also one
Black walnut Chest — Also leave my Will to be sold to
the Highest Bidder and the Money to be Equally Divided
between my three Sons (to wit, Benjamin Spencer, John Spencer
and Thomas Spencer, All and Singular the rest of my Estate
be it of what kind or Quality soever I have to my wellbelov'd
Wife Elizabeth Spencer (During her Natural Life or widowhood
(Including my Station and Bay Horse called the Bracken
horse which is to be sold to pay my Debts) and at her
Death or Enter Marriage all is to return to my son Thomas
Spencer

I Do appoint my wellbelov'd Wife Elizabeth Spencer
and my two Sons Benjamin Spencer and John Spencer whole
and Sole Executors of this my last will & Testament, Revoking
and Disannulling all and every other Will or Wills by me her-
etofore made, Publishing and Declaring this to be my last
Will and Testament. Witness my hand & Seal this Eleventh day of July in the year
of our Lord Christ One Thousand seven hundred & Eighty One
