of the said Court made the 4th day of June anno dom 1792
and according to the Directions of our Gen^d Assembly in
that case made and provided doth place and bind unto
the said Robert Payne, John S Brown an orphan now
of the age of Sixteen years and Seven months with the said
Robert Payne to live after the manner of an apprentice and servant
shall attain the age of Twenty one years during which time
his said Master faithfully shall serve his lawfull
Commands every Gladly obey shall not at any time absent
himself from his said Master service without leave but
in all things as is good and faithfull Servant shall behave
towards his said Master, and the said Robert Payne
doth covenant to and with the said William Moore that
he will teach or cause to be Taught the said Orphan to
Read Write and Cylphie according to Law and also teach
one cause to be Taught and Instructed the Art and Business
of Silversmith and that he will constantly find and provide
for the said Apprentice During the Term whereof sufficient
Diet Lodging and apparel for him to be an apprentice
and all other things necessary both in Lecture and in
Health in Witness whereof the Parties to these Presents have
interchangably set their hands and seals this day and year
