 that Case made and provided doth place and bind unto
 the said Robert Payne, John S. Moore an Orphan now of
 the age of Twelve years and Six Months with the said
 Robert Payne to live after the manner of an apprentice and servant
 shall attain the age of Twenty one years During all which
 time his said Master faithfully shall serve his Lawfull
 Commands every Gladly Obey shall not at any time absent
 himself from his said Masters service without leave but
 in all things as a good and faithful Servant shall behave
 towards his said Master, and the said Robert Paynes
 doth Covenant to and with the said William Moore that
 he will Teach or cause to be Taught the said Orphan to
 Read Write and Cypher according to Law and also teach
 or cause to be Taught and Instructed the Art and Mystery
 of Linnen Smiths and that he will constantly feed and provide
 for the said Apprentice During the Term years sufficient
 Diet Working Lodging and apparel Suitable for an apprentice
 and all other things necessary both in Sickness and in
 Health In Witness whereof the Parties to these Conditions hath
 Interchangeably set their hands and seals the day and year

 and Robert Payne of the other Part Witnesses that the said
 William Moore Esq^r in pursuance to an Order of the said
 Court made the 5th day of March 1782 and according to the
 Directions of our Gen^l Assembly in that Case made and
 provided doth put place and bind unto the said Robert
 Payne William Taylor an Orphan now of the age of
 Seventeen years with the said Robert Payne to live after the
 manner of an apprentice and Servant until he shall
 attain the age of Twenty one year During all which time
 his said Master he faithfully shall serve his Lawfull
 Commands every when Gladly Obey he shall not at any
 time absent himself from his said Masters service without
 leave but in all things as a good and faithful Servant
 shall behave towards his said Master

And the said Robert Payne doth Covenant to and with
 the said William Moore that he will Teach and Instruct or cause
 to be taught and Instructed the said William Taylor to read Write
 and Cypher according to Law and also to Teach him the said
 William Taylor the art and mystery of Blacksmiths and Linnen
 Smiths and that he will constantly feed and provide for the said
 apprentice during the Term years sufficient Diet Working Lodging
 and apparel Suitable for an apprentice and all other things
 necessary both in Sickness and in Health In Witness
 whereof the Parties to these Conditions hath Interchangeably set
