that Samuel Hetheron Dierased, or, Giveng and granting unto my said
Attorney by these presents my full Powers Strength and Authority and
About the Premises to have use and Take all Lawfull way and mean
in my Name to Make Seal and Deliver and Generally all and every
Other Act and Law thinge and thinge Power and Dower in the Law
That is to saye and Mysfayre Present in and about the Premises for me
and in my Name to do Create and Perform as fully largely and afflytelye
Intents and Purposes as I my selfe might or could do if I were personally present
or as if the Master Required more special Authority than is herein appoynted
and Allowis one or more under the sume of One Thousand pounds Sterl for the
Purposes afores^d and holding for forme and Effectually all and what ever my
said Attorney shall Lawfully in and about the Premises by Order hereof
Intitulys Wherof These huncroftes at my hand and seal the 1st day of June 1783

that the said William Moore Esq^r in Pursuance of his an Order of the said
Court Made the day of the date hereof and According to the Act of Our
Gen^r Assembly in that Case made and provided doth full Place and lead
unto the said William Lee, Solomon Parks Lee, An Orphan Now of the
Age of Nine years and Ten Months to live after the Manner of an
Apprentice to serve until he attain to the age of Twenty one years
During at which time his said Master faithfully shall Serve his said
Command and every when Gladly Obey he shall not at any time Absent himself
from his said Master Service without leave haden all things as aforesaid and
faithfull Servant when he combs his said Master After the said
William Lee doth Covenant promise and agree to and with the said William
Moore that he Will Teach or cause to be Taught and Instructed the said
Orphan to read, Writ, and Cylph according to Law and else to —
Perform his in the Mangement of a Planter and that he will constantly
serve and provide for the said Apprentice Sufficient diet Housing Lodging
and Apparel during the Term aforesaid and all Other Things necessary
