of December 1872. First it is my will that after my

shall have all my land that I now live on
and shall share and have alike it being the adjoining
land of A. Null Jacob Winebarger and others and it is
my will that my daughters Sally and Barbara shall have
all the corn & wheat on hand also two killing hogs
and six of the 1st choice out hogs. also it my will that
my daughter Barbara shall have viz one mare

to have and to hold for her own ^{use} benefit as she
may choose.

It is my will that all my personal property
or the remainder of it shall be sold to the highest
bidder by my Executor here after named & shall
be divided between all my heirs, share and share
a like. I hereby appoint my son John Coons Executor
of my last will and testament. Signed, Sealed &
Delivered in presence of the day and date above
Ambrose Null named Adam Coons
