In the Name of God Amen, I Adam Grib of the County of Catawba & State of North Carolina Being of sound mind & memory but Considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make & declare this my last will & Testament in manner and form following that is to say  
 That my executors here after named shall provide for my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my relatives & friends and pay all funeral expenses together with my just debts burthen and to whomsoever owing out of the Maries that may first come into his hands as a part or part of my estate  
 First I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Ruthy the two Lots in Newton where I now live together with the dwelling house and all out houses in the said two Lots, Also a tract of land lying near Newton known by the name of Shufey's tract and I do hereby put her in possession of all the above named physicians in Clarendon the first sectione living her natural life or state of widowhood and provide she merris in other her death the aforesaid Lots & land above mentioned shall beling to my son-in-law John Hayes I also will & bequeath to my beloved wife Ruthy two negroes namely Candy & Harry and her increase also one nego boy named Allen, And after the death of my wife my will is that my son-in-law John Hayes is to have Candy Ruthy my house her choice two cows her choice seven hogs her choice with house hold & kitchen furniture including all the beds cupboards Bureaus and every thing in the house and kitchen, one wash foot her choice - washing tubs & her stinks all the meat all the grain, flour cotton & soap vinegar Potatoes in hand at my death or as much as will be sufficient for the support of her & her family for one year if there shalts not be sufficiency of grain & meat in hand at my death to support my aforesaid wife and family for one year, it is my will that my executors is to furnish what is required and charge my estate with the same

2<sup>d</sup> I will & bequeath to my four daughters namely Esty, Mrs Lydia Hanover Sarah Hayes & Merrit all the property I will die to my wife Ruthy after her death (Sarah & Merrit accepted) is to be equally divided between them and if they cannot agree the are to leave it to two unnumbered men

3<sup>d</sup> I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah R B Hayes one nego girl named Betsy & her increase three beds of furniture one bureau & candlestand and my will is that her mother furnish her with the necessary things of house keeping

4<sup>d</sup> I will and bequeath to my daughter Harriet my plantation lying on South fork known by the name Hayes tract joining Hollie River & call 190 acres also one nego girl named Rich & her increase three beds of furniture one Bureau and candlestand and my will is that her Mother furnish her with the necessary things for Master keeping

5<sup>th</sup> I will and bequeath to my daughter Esty by my tract of land known by the name of Willow Citherspoon tract & call 88 acres plairing Elsie Lucy  
 I also will & bequeath to Lydia Hanover my tract of land known by the name of Canada tract lying on the opposite of a Branch It is my will & desire that all my property that is not disposed of by this my last will & Testament at my death is to be sold by my executors as aforesaid and the proceeds thereof to be equally divided between my wife & four daughters  
 It is my will that my wife & my four daughters shall have an equal part in the five hundred dollars that I subscribed to the Rail Road to that I do hereby constitute & appoint my Trusty friend Henry Clinne my lawful executor to all intents and purposes to execute this my last will & Testament according to the true intent & meaning of the same and every Part thereof, hereby revoking & declaring utterly void all other wills & Testaments by me hitherto made  
 In witness whereof I the said Adam Grib do hereunto set my hand & seal this 23<sup>d</sup> day of August AD 1861
