"North Carolina, Catawba County.
In the name of God, Amen!
I, Andrew H. Shuford, of the County and State
aforesaid, being of sound mind and senses, but
in feeble health and advanced age, which forcibly
reminds me that all men are born to die, and
in all human probability my time on earth is
nearly ended, do make and publish this my last
Will and Testament. I bequeath in the bequest of
my soul to God who gave
it, and my body a decent burial, suitable to
my limited means and the wishes of my
wife and children.

2 After the payment of my just debts, (if any remain
due and unpaid at the time of my death) I will
and devise to my beloved wife Elvira Shuford
all my estate of every description and character
consisting of the House & Lot on which we now
live, all the House Hold & Kitchen furniture, notes
and accounts and money on hand, all cattle
crop stock and provisions, also all my personal
estate or right and interest in and to any
and all bonds, mines minerals, tools or
other thing or things owned and held
by the Sixes Mining Company of Georgia as
evidenced by the certificates of stock issued
to me, and thirty one shares issued to S.
H. Shuford, which property lies in Cherokee
County State of Georgia.

I also will and devise to my said wife
Elvira all my interest and estate in and
to the "Bals Ground" mine and lands belonging
thereto in the State of Ga. which together
with all the above mentioned property &
estate of every kind and description which
I own in either the State of Georgia she shall
own possess, occupy and dispose of at her
will and pleasure. Lastly I nominate and
appoint my respected son in law Henry Milford
my lawful Executor and confidential
adviser of my wife, for her benefit.
