153 Of Abraham Smith of the County of Catawba & state of North Carolina being of sound mind & memory but Considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare This my last Will & Testament in manner & form following That is to say

First that my executor hereafter named, shall provide for my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my relatives and friends and pay all funeral expenses to gether with my just debts however and to whomsoever owing out of the monies that may first come into his hands as a part or parcel of my estate

Item I give & devise to my beloved wife Rhoda all my estate both real & personal to have & to hold to her the said Rhoda Smith for and during the term of her natural life in this life for & in lieu of her due & thirs of & in all my estate & after her decease of my beloved wife Rhoda my executor will dispose to publick use all my estate both real & personal and divide the proceeds as shall be hereinafter named.

Item I give & devise my son James Anderson fifty dollars Item I give & devise to my son Robert's children of the State of Texas five dollars Item I give & devise to my son Thomas' children of the State of Florida five dollars Item I give & devise to my son Benjamin five dollars of the state of Tennessee.

Item I give & devise to my daughter Emily Charles' children five dollars

Item I give & devise to my daughter Sally Lassiter's children five dollars

Item I give & devise to my Daughter Maryannah McCombs shall be herafter named. Item I give & devise to my grand Daughter Zilocha McCombs one hundred Dollars Item I give and devise to my Grand Daughter Ellen McCombs one hundred Dollars

Item I give and devise to my grand Daughter Sarah Jane McCombs one hundred dollars

Item I give & bequeath to my grandson Robert McCombs one hundred dollars Item my will & desire is that all the residue of my estate if any after taking out the devises & legacies above mentioned shall be equally divided & paid over to my daughter Maryannah McCombs four children to have & to hold forever

and lastly I do hereby constitute & appoint my trusty friend Dr J A Herrell my lawful executor to all intents & purposes to execute this my last will & testament according to the true intent & meaning of the same & every Part thereof & clause thereof hereby reciting & disclaiming utterly void all other wills & testaments by me heretofore made in writing whereof the said Abraham Smith do hereby set my hand & seal this 5<sup>th</sup> day of January A.D. 1864

Located laying in the waters of the creek gaining lands of John Young James James P. C. Lawrence Dennis and others and also all my house hold & kitchen furniture all my corn & wheat on hand & moreover also nineteen head of hogs four head of cattle & all my money bank & accounts are here in now more six years old one buggy and harness a one horse wagon & harness all my farming utensils and bedding & barou & my part of the growing crop during the term of her natural life and widowhood, and after her death to be divided among my heirs likewise I make constitute and appoint my said wife execu tor of this my last will & testament In witness whereof I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal the Fifth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & Sixty two.
