" In the name of God Amen; I Daniel B. Whitener of the state of North Carolina & County of Catawba Being of a sound disposing mind and memory do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner & form following: First I give & bequeath unto my wife Catharine all my land my house and furniture and all my personal property during her natural life and widowhood and if she should marry again then she is to draw an equal part with my three daughters herein after mentioned after her decease all my land to fall to my two sons Franklin Whitener & G. Logan Whitener to be equally divided among themselves

Next I will that my daughter Eliza Whitener if in case she shall remain single she is to have a股份 from the above named Land & plantation after my wife's decease then all my personal property to be sold at public sale & equally divided between my three daughters Simon Lips P. Eliza Whitener A. Mahala Garrett

I appoint Daniel Garrett and Franklin Whitener my Executors of this my last Will and Testament in witnesses whereof I have hereunto set my hands and seal this sixth day of April in the year of our Lords one thousand eight hundred & fifty two 1852
