

The last Will and Testament of Daniel B. Whiteman

" On the name of God Amen; I Daniel B. Whiteman of the state of North Carolina & County of Catawba Being of a sound disposing mind and memory do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner & form following: First I give & bequeath unto my wife Catharine all my Land my house and furniture and all my personal property during her natural life and widowhood and if she should marry again then she is to draw an equal part with any three daughters hereinafter mentioned after her decease all my land to fall to my two sons Franklin Whiteman & G. Logan Whiteman to be equally divided among themselves

Next I will that my daughter Eliza Whiteman if in case she shall remain single she is to have a support from the above named Land & plantation after my wifes decease then all my personal property to be sold at publick sale & equally divided between any three daughters since Lips L. Eliza Whiteman A. Mahaly Garrett

I appoint Daniel Garrett and Franklin Whiteman my Executors of this my last Will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this sixth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & fifty two 1852
