of life. I deem it necessary to make provision for my wife
Catharine. I therefore give and bequeath unto my beloved wife
Catharine during her natural life time or widow hood. all my
Land and household goods also my negro Woman Rach
my old and new Wagon all my Stock of horses both hags &
Sheep also my blacksmith Shop. Together with all the crop of every
kind consisting of Wheat & Corn & all hay & fodder & every of all
kind farming utensils horse hots & kitchen furniture. &c. &
I also give & bequeath unto my sons & daughters that is
Elizabeth John Daniel & Polly the sum of Ten Shillings each
This I deem my last will and Testament I further appoint
John Wierick executor of the same in confirmation whereof
I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 30th day of October
