In the name of God amen

I Daniel Miller of the County of Lancaster & State of North Carolina
being in declining mind & memory but in full health and
visiting the University of North Carolina the humble family soon or
later I do hereby make certain & declare the following articles
& items to be my last Will & Testament etc.

1^o I will & desire that my mortal remains be buried in a
decent & Christian like manner my grave to be marked with
respectable Tombstones the expenses to be paid out of my estate.
2^o I will & direct that all my last debts be paid out of my estate
and so to the worldly effects which God has been pleased to
help me with I will bequeath & dispose of in the following
manner viz:

1^o I give & bequeath to my wife Anna during her natural life or
widowhood the sole use & benefit of half my land which I
may die possessed of all my farming utensils namely my
Waggons Haws Haws the two Brakock geese & grape vines
about mill chains horse grazing my family carriage & harness
with all my kitchen furniture of all kinds also all my out houses
or large plots out of doors clothing dishes & plates the wear of all
families with the kitchen tables & Cupboards also of my household
furniture all my bed clothing Bedrooms Cupboards & Cupboards
setting chairs fire tools looking glasses and all other houses fur
niture belonging to me at my death also my clock one side table
& one man saddle Choice of what may be in hand also two riding
bridles also three head of horses his choice out of my stock &
hand all my stock of Cattle hogs & sheep & Poultry of all kinds
all the hay straw fodder & fence of all kinds all the corn in the
fallot crib supposed to be near four hundred bushels all the wheat
& flour in hand & a sufficiency of the growing crops of wheat
for the use of my said wife & family for two years after harvest
time & also for sowing purposes and all my potatoes of both kinds
& all the fay & tea & Cotton in hand also my negro girl Anna now
about eight years old all the above named property is given &
bequeathed to my wife Anna during her widowhood but then to my
first wife Anna chose to marry again then it is my will & desire
that she receive her undivided in my lands ^{as} the law directs and
also that she share equal with each of my children in the proceeds
of all personal property money & effects including the above named
property that may remain at the time of her marriage except such
as may hereafter be bequeathed or appropriated

2^o in as much as my children which I have by my first wife Anna
namely Camilla, Harriet, Sarah Ann, Adeline & James Monroe

have herebefore drawn all the Legacy drawn by their mother Anna
from her Brothers & Sisters Estate mostly now in my hands
as their Guardian & therefore give and bequeath unto my wife Anna &
all my children which I have by her all the property & money which
has come into my hands as the legal representation of my wife Anna
from her deceased Father her deceased Brother Jacob & deceased Sister Elizabeth
estate which amounts can be ascertained by reference to the records of
the County Court this request to be paid up with what funds my remains
after paying off my just debts both personal & as guardian as above stated
or so much of it as the funds will pay the remainder if any to be paid off
at the final settlement of my estate

3^o My further will & desire is & I hereby so will & direct that whatever funds
may remain & belong to my estate over and above the bequests & directions
 herein named are fulfilled first & last be equally divided between my
wife Anna and all my children taking into Consideration the property
or money which has been hitherto given by me to any of my said children
as aforesaid.

4^o I further will & direct that of the funds which may fall into the hands
& of my executor from cash funds on hand or from sale of Property
I may & shall remain after fulfilling the above bequests and directions
the same shall be divided equally between my wife Anna & all my children
as directed in article 3^o as soon as such fulfillment is made.

5^o I further will & direct that my executor hereinafter to be named sell
out of my Property not herein disposed of at public sale my negroes
included & appropriate the proceeds as above directed.

6^o I will & direct that my lands be equally divided at the proper time
between all my children.

7^o I hereby nominate constitute and appoint my friend E. J. Compton
my lawful Executor of this my last will & Testament hereby making
& amending all other will or Executors before made by me

my seal this the 30th day of January in the year of our Lord
one Thousand eight hundred & sixty three
