69 In the name of God Amen I David Robinson of the County of
Catawba and State of North Carolina, being in full health and
consciousness to be, through of following friends and many dispa-
chee have for the same having before me consideration that I do long
to ~~unquestion~~ make and publish this my last Will and Testament
in manner and form as follows viz,

I, J. J. and Aqueduct unto my love eldest daughter Sarah & Elizabeth the plantation which I now live known at the estate that for the term of ten years as a house for them and my youngest daughter Mary Ann, I will and bequeath to my two daughters Sarah & Elizabeth my negro man Solomon seven head of cattle three chairs two brass & brass three chairs one head of bed three chairs six of my best hogs three chairs & one sack & the pigs all my wheat seed as much of my crop of corn & oats as my executor except the named my debt sufficient for the subject of my farming of 5000 dollars and with me at the time named my love John Chase & Samuel & my three daughters Sarah Elizabeth & Mary Ann I also will and bequeath to my two daughters Sarah & Elizabeth all my house hold and kitchen furniture all my farming tools & necessary gearings for the two negroes I have bequeathed to them, three in two side saddles at my house I bequeath one of them to my daughter Elizabeth and one to my daughter Mary Ann the plantation & negro that I have bequeath to my two daughters the plantation to be sold at public sale of my executor and the two acres at any time my daughter may think proper together with the consent of my executor my negro man Solomon that I have willed to them for ten years to be sold by my executor at any time within the ten years, with the consent of my two daughters at public sale to some person that in thinks may deal more well as in her always live faithful & trusty to me I wish my executor to pick the purchaser & sell him privately to the best advantage he can? I will and bequeath a man saddle that I got of my son James & Robinson due to my son Chase, 3rd the balance of my property that is not named together with my Baltimore tract of land to be sold my debt & to be paid the balance of the money if any to be equally divided among all my children what Robinson due Robinson George Robinson Mithersdick Robinson Jesse Robinson & Maywell Robinson which are my two sons & my three daughters namely Sarah Elizabeth & Mary Ann & also the balance of my property that I have willed to my two daughters namely my plantation two horses that are to be sold public sale my negro boy that is to be sold privately the proceeds of all to be equally divided among all my children lastly I constitute and appoint Rev. R. Shupard as my executor for this my last will and Testament working all others, as witness I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 12 day of July 1830. Signed & att. in the presence of

I Margaret Hull of the County of Catawba and State of North Carolina, being of sound mind and memory, but coming to the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say.

I trust that my expatriation hereafter manumitted shall provide for my
body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my relations and
friends and pay all funeral & services together with my last debts
and of the manner that may first come into his hands as a part or
part of my estate

Item I Give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Bridges
Twenty dollars which is her share of my estate that I intend for her
Item 3rd I Give and bequeath to my daughter Susan

Item 3rd I gave and leguents to my daughter Susan Shaw
One hundred and sixty dollars

Alms 4th given and bequeathed to my daughter Elizabeth Lallen
One hundred dollars

Then I give and bequeath to my son John Hill, one hundred
Dollars in Cash and my black & my Black Smith Tools.

Item 64 I give and bequeath to my daughter Anna Main
One hundred Dollars

Item 7th. I give and bequeath my negro boy Sam to my daughter
Elizabeth Pollar and to my son John Hull equally and they
are to clothe him and take care of him and if Elizabeth
Pollar dies before John Hull and the boy Sam in that
event Sam is to go to John Hull as his own property.

Item 8th: My wife and issue is that all the residue of my property or estate if any after taking out the debts and legacies above mentioned shall be sold and the debts owing to me collected and if there should be any Surplus over and above the payment of debts expenses and legacies that such Surplus shall be equally divided between my daughter Anna, Mary and my son John half to share alike.

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend & friend
Samantha and my son John full my lawful Executors to
all intents and purposes to execute this my last will and Testam-
ent according to the true intent and meaning of the same and
every part and clause thereof hereby revoking & declaring utterly
void all other wills and Testaments by me heretofore made
In witness Whereof I the said Margaret full do known to my hand
and Seal this 1 day of December A.D. 1847.
